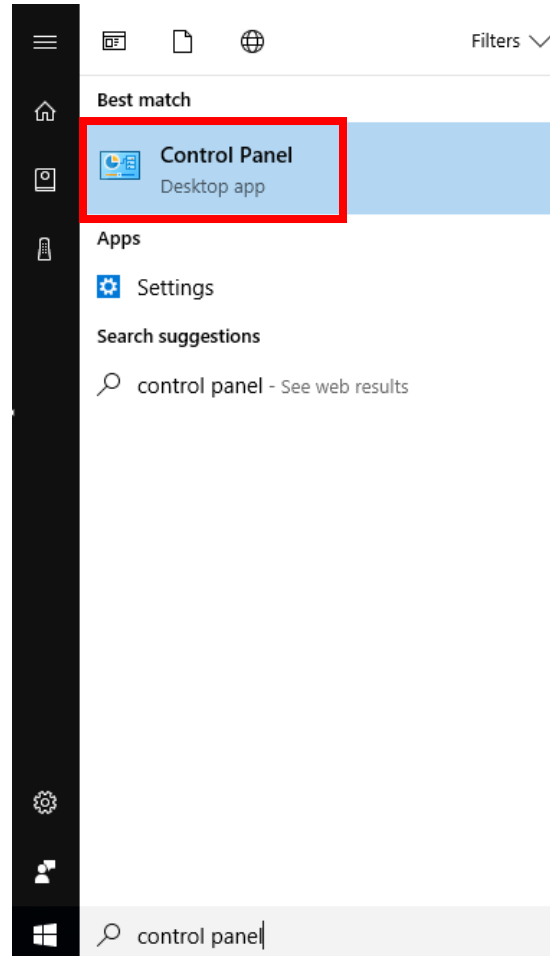


Confirming your PC is obtaining the DNS address automatically

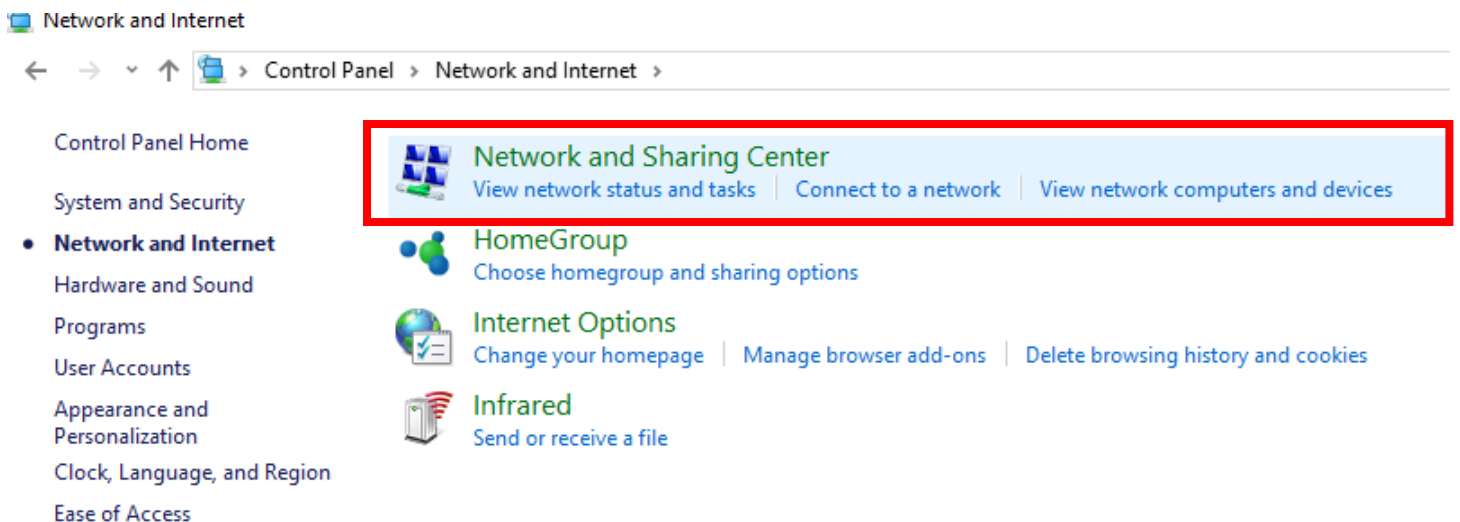
In order for your PC to connect to UL WiFi we recommend setting the wireless adaptor to obtain a DNS address automatically. Most machines will have this setting turned on by default.

Below are instructions on how to confirm your PC is obtaining a DNS address automatically

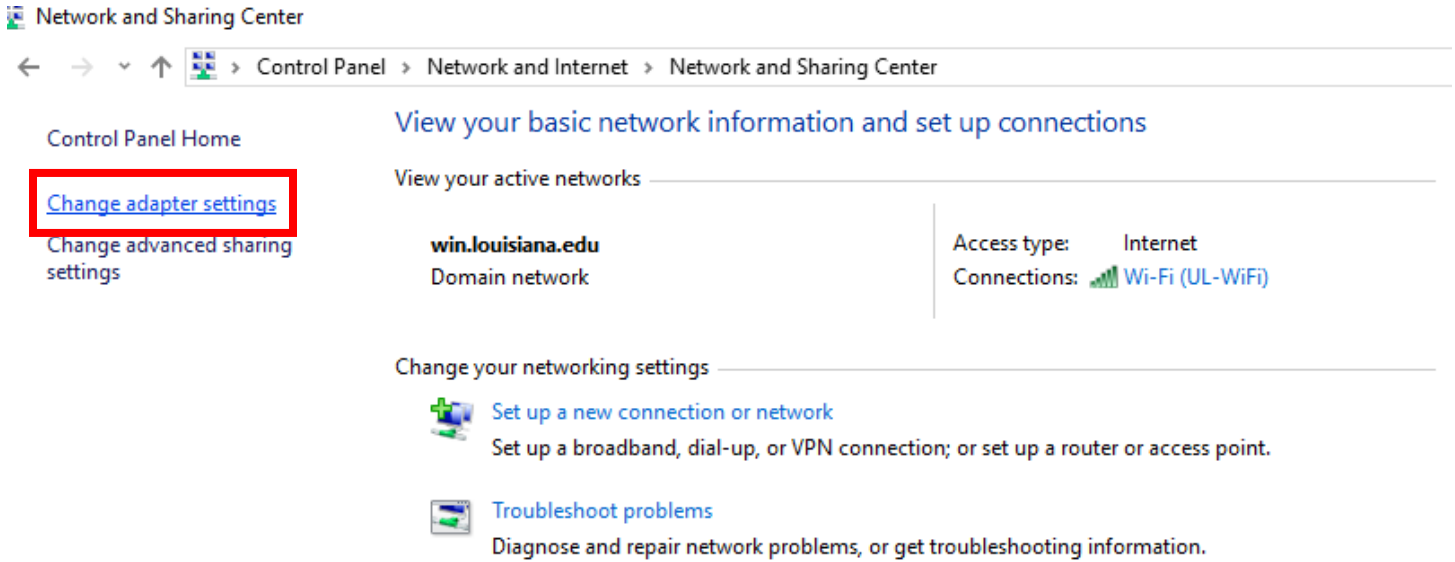
1. Open the Control Panel



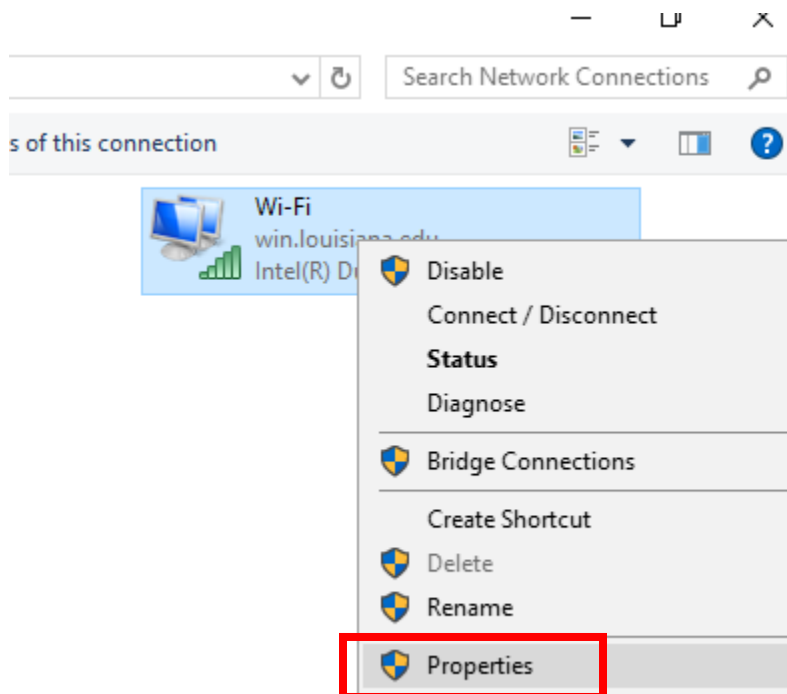
2. Open Network & Share Center



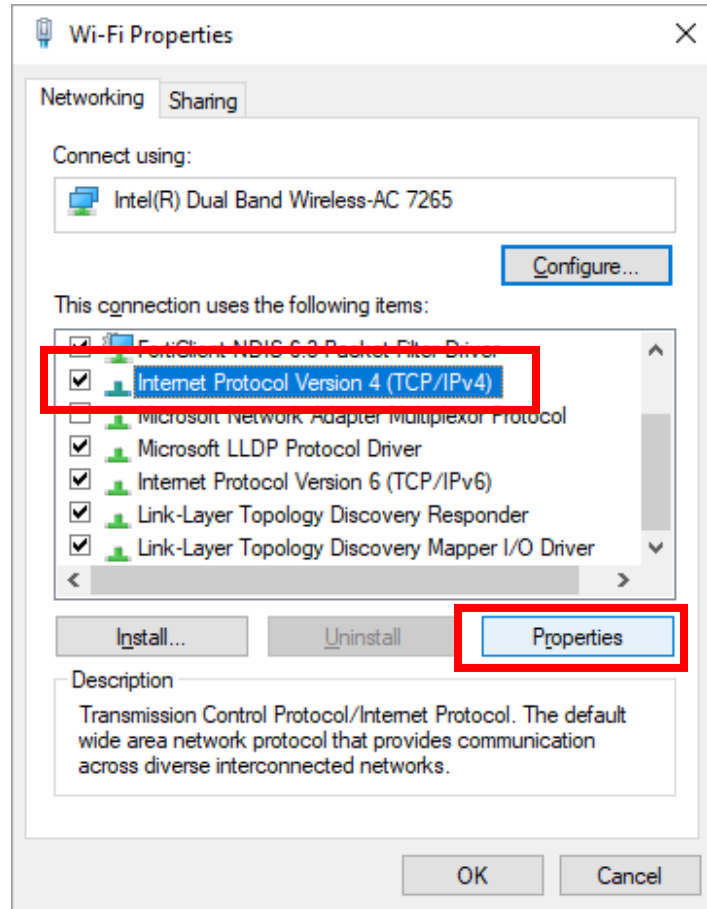
3. Click **Change adapter settings**



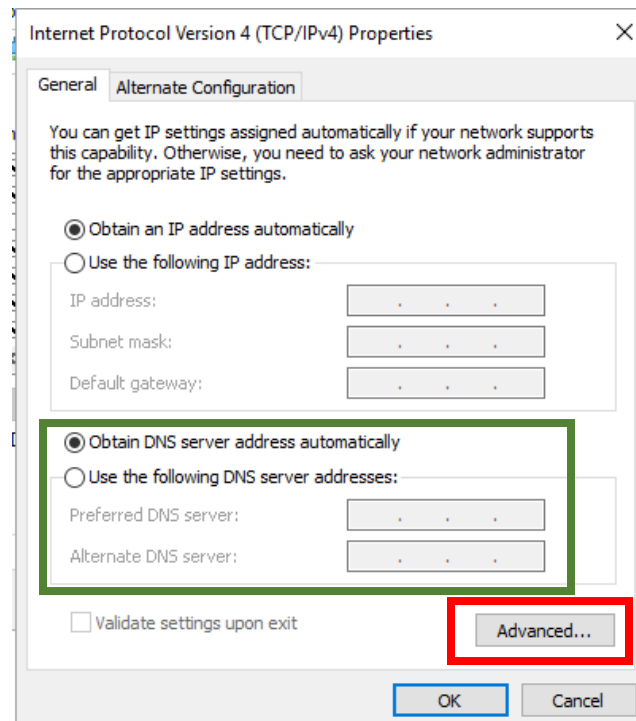
4. **Right-click** on the Wi-Fi adaptor and choose **Properties**



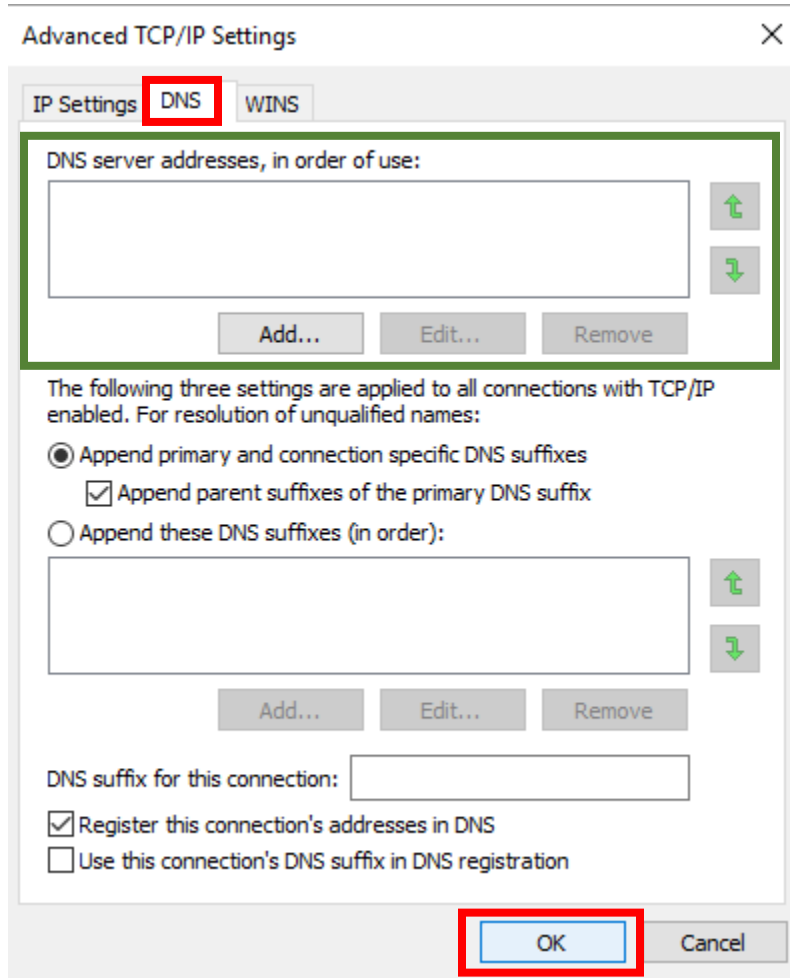
5. Click *Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4)* to highlight that option, then click **Properties**
Note: DO NOT uncheck Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4)



6. Confirm both sections in the *Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4)* window have **Obtain an IP address automatically** selected. If **Obtain an IP address automatically** is not selected, select the option by clicking the radio button next to the text.



7. Click Advanced, then click the DNS tab, confirm that nothing is listed in the DNS server addresses box. If an address is listed, select the address and click Remove.



8. It is important the exit each window by clicking Apply or OK (clicking Cancel will cause any changes you made not to save).
